Preparing for Senior Week:

Purchasing Your Pass- Senior Week passes will be sold for \$110. All seniors who have previously bought a senior card will receive a discount that cuts the price of their pass in half, to \$55. In order to participate in Senior Week a pass must be purchased. This pass is the ticket into every event from Kickoff to Formal. Passes will be available to purchase specifically for Senior Splash, and guest passes will be available for Formal, but all other events are exclusive to pass holders.

Pass sales will begin on April 7 for everyone who has purchased a senior card earlier in the year, and April 9 for all seniors. Pass sales will close at the end of the day on April 10. From that

point on passes will no longer be available. Be sure to purchase your pass during this week so you don't miss out on your chance to participate in Senior Week 2015!

O'Brien stressed the importance of making sure that every senior knew about these dates. "We can only sell passes for that limited window of time. Once we close sales on the 10th, there aren't going to be any more pass sales, and that's not something we can be flexible on. Venues and catering need exact head counts for each event well in advance and that's not something we can change when people e-mail us asking to buy a pass a couple days before Senior Week. It's not a great position to be in, but it's something that's out of our control at that point."

Picking up your pass: Passes will be distributed to all seniors who purchased them from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. on May 7 and 8. At that time seniors will also receive a shirt to wear the day of Senior Splash, a bracelet that will serve as their pass, and a schedule of events. No pass will be given to anybody except the purchaser, so the committee asks everyone to plan accordingly.

Included in the pass: Along with admission to each event, the purchase of a Senior Week pass allows access to transportation to and from each event, as well as food at each event. Most events will also feature a cash bar. No alcohol will be provided by the Senior Week Committee.
